



Energy Charter of Robert Laminage SA (RLSA)

At Robert Laminage SA (RLSA), we are deeply committed to respecting nature and the well-being of our employees, because we care about preserving our environment for future generations.

Our commitment to quality, supported by our environmental management, shows that RLSA is determined to act thoughtfully and responsibly from the outset.

Environmental Objectives:

We have set ourselves the target of reducing our environmental impact every year. As part of this commitment, we have signed an agreement with the Swiss Confederation to reduce our total energy consumption by 10% by 2027.

Specific commitments:

- **Green energy:** We use only energy from renewable sources to run our production equipment. At present, 90% of the electricity we consume comes from Swiss hydroelectricity and 10% from the recycling of Neuchâtel waste, as shown by our attached Vivalor certificate.
- Waste management: We rigorously sort all our waste:
 - Our raw material waste is recycled by an ISO 14001, ISO 9001 and OHSAS 18001 certified partner.
 - We also recycle PET, paper, cardboard, wood, used oil and any other waste from our activities.
- **Pollution prevention:** We take all necessary measures to prevent any form of environmental pollution.
- **Energy savings:** We do not use air conditioning or drinking water to cool our equipment. Cooling is provided by renewable energy technologies.
- **Choice of Suppliers:** We select suppliers who adopt environmental management systems, as part of our sustainable procurement approach.
- Working with customers: We work with our customers to help them produce while minimising their waste.

Ongoing commitment: At RLSA, our mission does not end with these commitments; we are constantly looking for new ways to improve our energy efficiency and reduce our environmental footprint even further.

We would like to thank you for your continued support and commitment to our responsible approach.
